
Different Letters Same Sound?

You may notice that one sound cue can have more than one corresponding letter (s).

For example:

- letters **f** and **ph** both make the **mad cat "ff" sound**
- ch and sh both make the quiet "shh" sound

Same Letter Different Sound?

On the other hand, one letter can make more than one sound. For example, the letter c can make the snake "sss" sound and the coughing "k k" sound, and the letter y makes four different sounds!!
