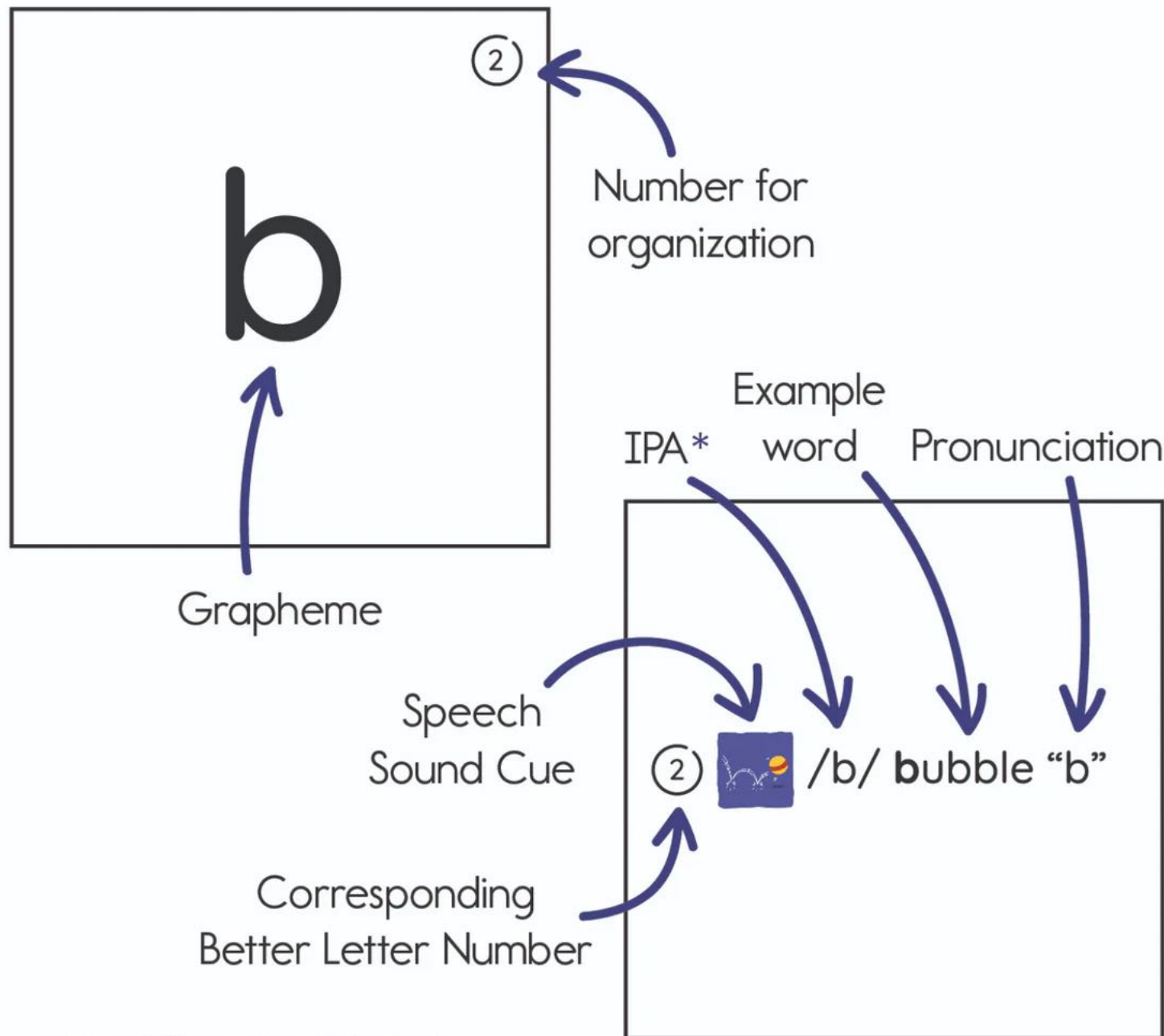


Anatomy of a Letter Card



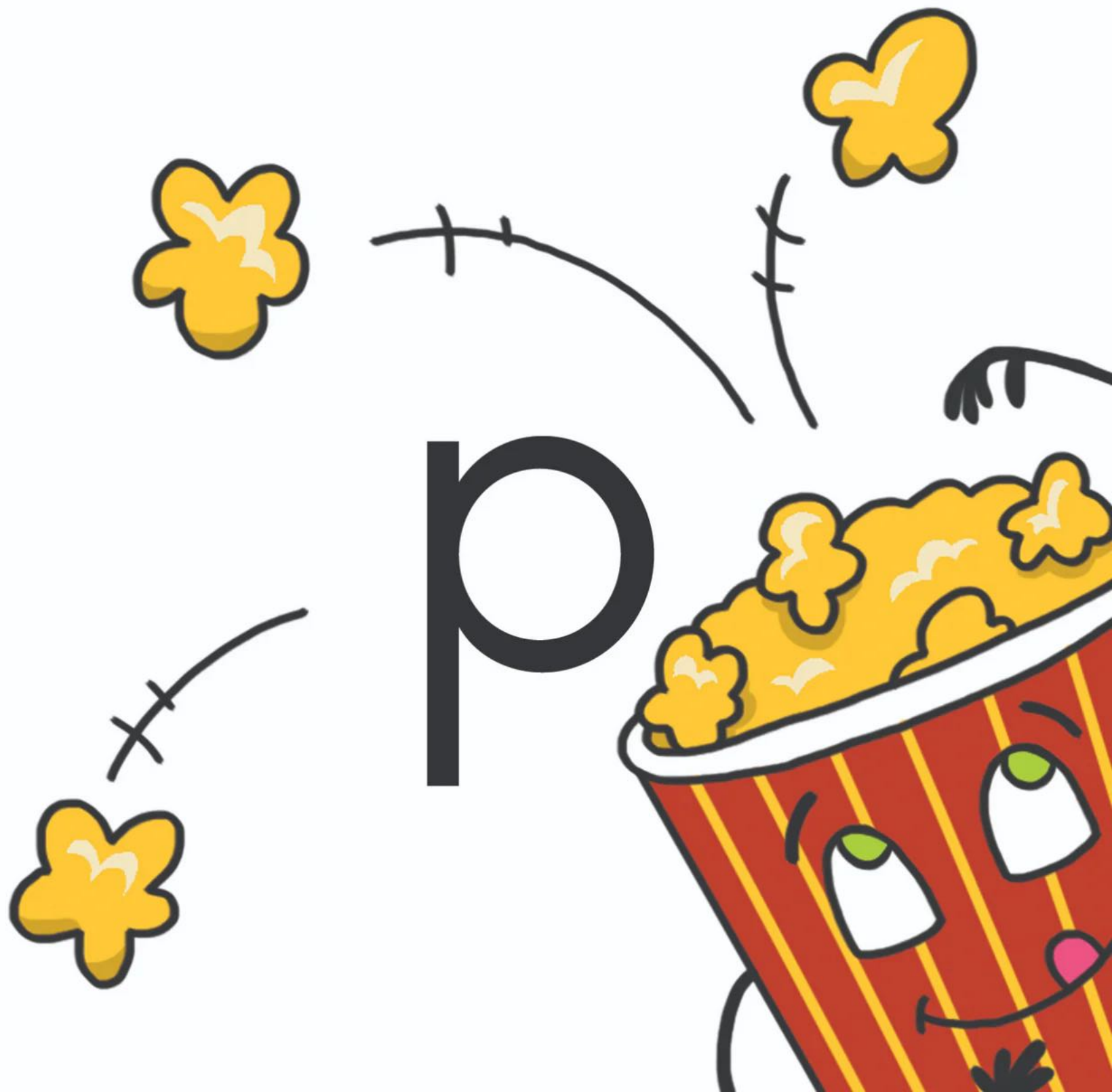

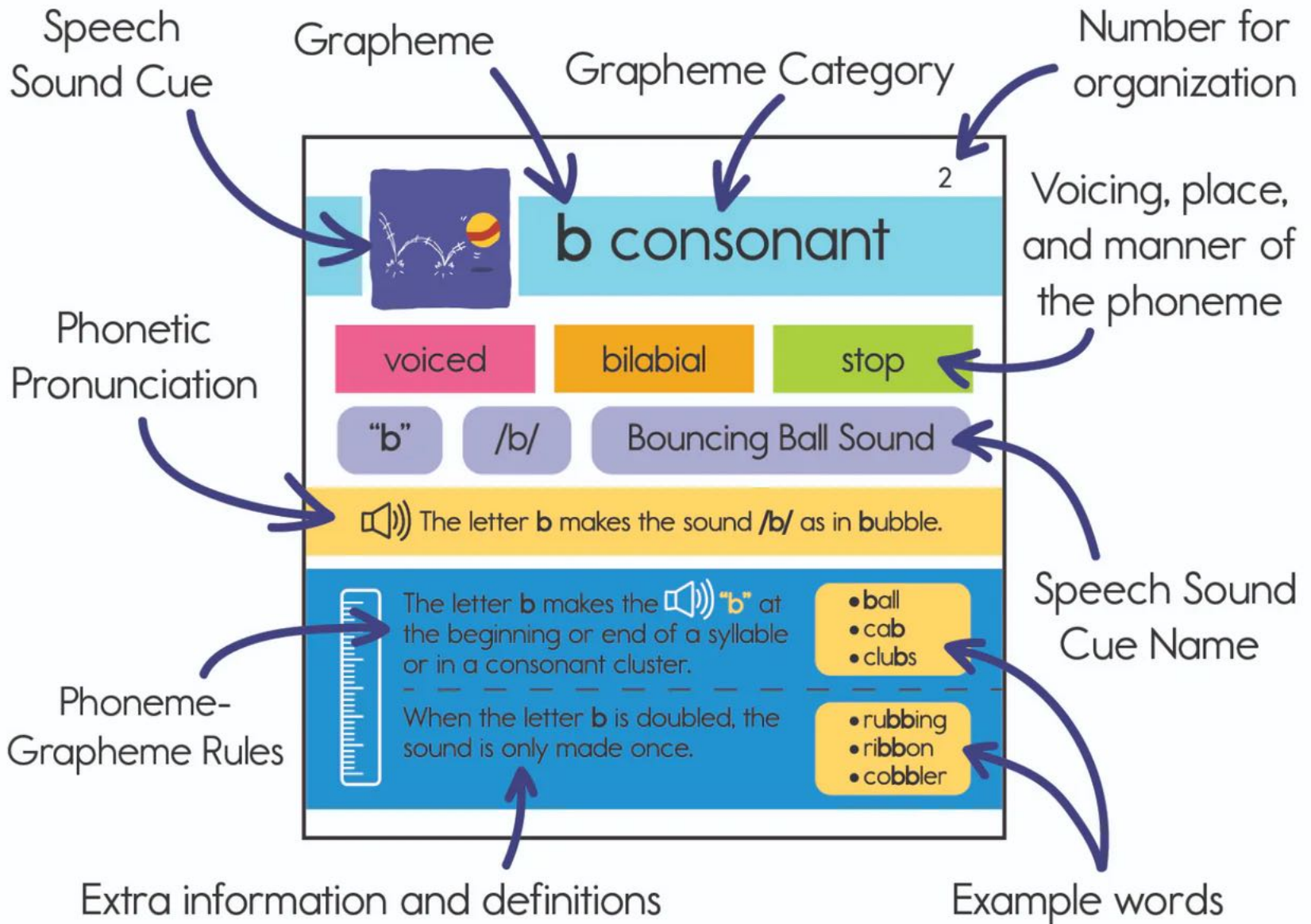

Anatomy of a Better Letter Back





p consonant

voiceless

bilabial

Popcorn Sound

 The letter **p** makes the sound /p/ as in pig.



The letter **p** makes the  “p” at the beginning or end of a syllable or in a consonant cluster.

When the letter **p** is doubled, the sound is only made once.
