












At the camp, a ramp tilts to the pond.

# Perfect Ponds

Ponds are a **habitat** for many plants and animals. Water lilies grow in ponds. Their leaf pads and flowers float on the water. Frogs lay their eggs in ponds. The eggs are clear, so you can watch the frogs **develop** inside. Fish swim in ponds. Some people build ponds as a home for a type of fish called koi.

Water lily flowers can be white, pink, purple, red, orange or yellow. Frogs lay their eggs in a big clump called frogspawn.

Koi look like giant goldfish, but they are actually a kind of **carp**.
