The activities allow children to explore art, movement, science and technology, writing, math, music, coloring, and structured group discussion.

TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Pass out the "Fun Facts about Dugongs" worksheet.
- Ask students to research fun and interesting facts about dugongs and answer the following questions:
 - 1. How can you estimate a dugong's age?
 - 2. How long can a dugong hold its breath?
 - 3. What is the closest land relative to the dugong?
 - 4. How long can a dugong live?
 - 5. How much does an average dugong weigh?
 - 6. What other interesting facts did you discover?
- Have students create a slideshow or video presentation that highlights the answers to each question and any other information students learned. Ask for volunteers to share their slideshows and videos with the class.
